- January 28, from 12 noon to 2 p.m.
- January 29, from 11:30 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Your poster should be displayed for the entire duration of the event. When you arrive at the Symposium on the morning of January 28, please go to the scientific poster room. There, you will find a plan showing you where you can set up your poster.



#### **Accommodation information**

For your convenience, we have reserved several rooms at the Hotel Bonaventure, located at 900 rue de la Gauchetière O, Montreal, QC H5A 1E4. <u>You can reserve your room</u> at the reduced price of \$239 per night, before taxes, for a double room.
